ART IN THE PARK takes place in Stratford at Lakeside Drive between Front and North Streets, every Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday, June through September. If you are accepted you are required to attend at least 10 times, otherwise to return the following year you will be required to reapply and be rejuried.

Exhibition is expected from 9 to 5. Art work must be original and must be signed. Original prints and photographs to be exhibited must be numbered and signed in an edition not to exceed 250. There are limits to the number of reproductions that may be shown. Some other rules apply to which you are required to acknowledge your compliance for acceptance in the Association.

Jurying Information

Artists and artisans to be juried please send:

- 1) Artists and artisans must submit 6 recent images (NO MORE, NO LESS than six images). If there are not exactly six images, your application will be returned. These images must accurately represent the type of work that will be exhibited and sold. Jurying is only from digital JPEG images. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure that all digital files are saved in the correct file format, can be opened, are not corrupted and are compatible with a PC.

Images must be maximum quality (180 dpi), submitted on one standard size Compact Disc (CD) stored in a jewel case labeled with your name. Each image must be labeled with your name, title and medium. Send the CD in a protective mailer. CD's will be kept on file if accepted.

- 2) A brief description of your technique.
- 3) A brief biography.

- 6) A nonrefundable cheque for \$25.00 for the jury fee.
- 7) A second cheque for \$285.00 (\$150.00 membership fee plus \$135.00 trader's fee) to be returned if you are not accepted.
- 4) A self-addressed, stamped envelope with sufficient postage to return your CD.
- 5) Complete application information. you are required to acknowledge your compliance for acceptance in the Association.

The following kinds of work are not accepted:

- any work that originates from commercial patterns or kits
- ceramics from commercial moulds
- clothing, needlework, knitting, crocheting

You will be notified as soon as possible of the jury's decision and of opening day.
